I. Overview

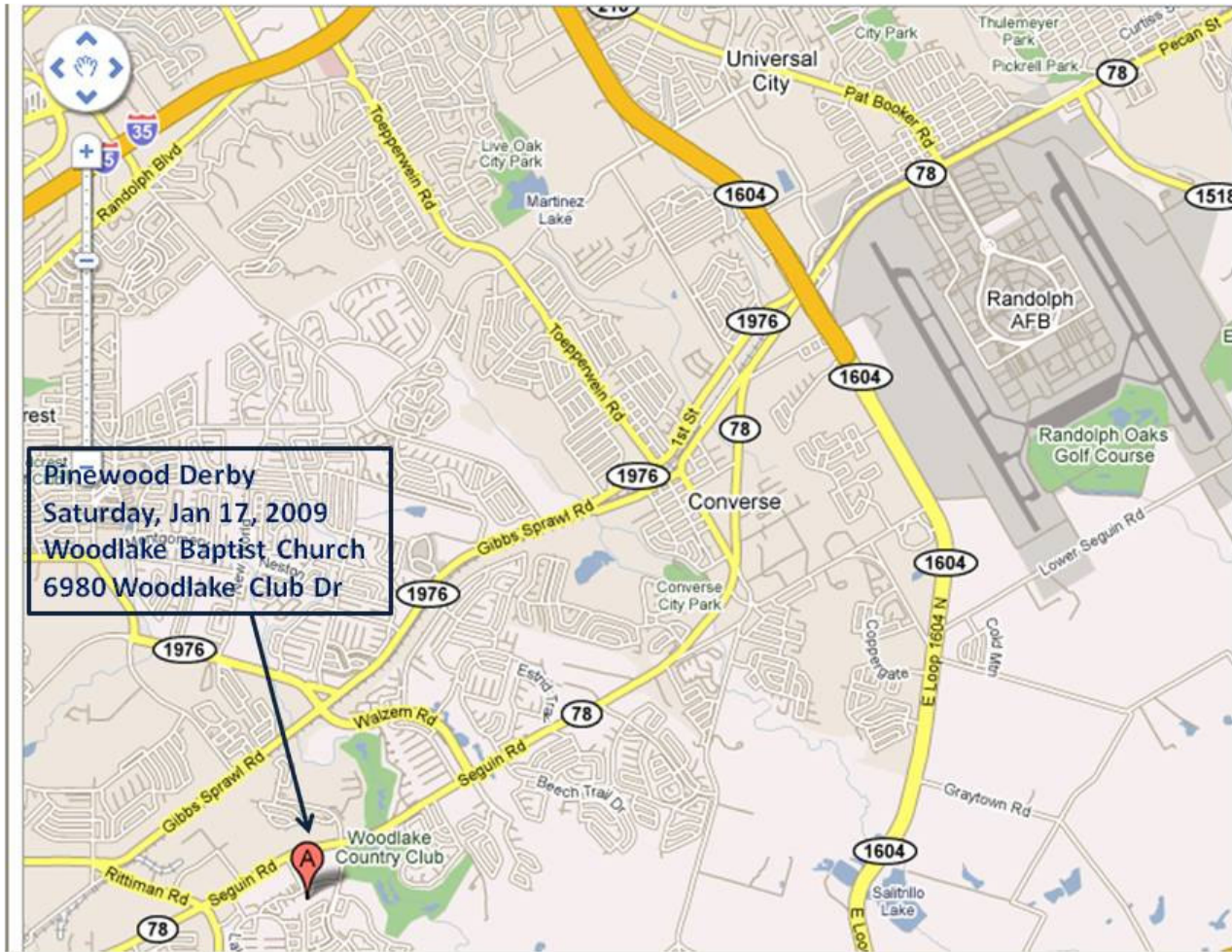
Event: Pack 172 Pine Wood Derby (PWD)

II. Time Line:

8:00 AM: Setup volunteers arrive (you people know who you are)

8:30 – 9:30 AM: Mandatory Car Check-in for everyone, including siblings and adults. Scout must be present with their car. Anyone not "checked-in" by 9:30 AM will NOT be allowed to race, nor will they be eligible for any other awards.

9:30 AM: Scouts will vote for winners of the "Special Category" trophies. Rules for voting will be posted at the ballot box. Only scouts (not siblings and adults) will vote and be eligible to win these awards.

The Special Categories are:

Best in Show

Most Unlike a car

Most Original Shape

I Did it Myself

Fastest Looking

Best Paint Job

Most Unique Design

Once everyone has voted, the races /events will begin in this order:.

Wolf Races

Awards will be presented for the Special Categories

Race Finals (Top 2 finishers from each Den)

Sibling Races

Adult Races

Awards Presented for Top 4 finishers of Pack 172, Top 3 in each Den, and all Participants

III. Special Notes:

- A. Official Rules are posted on the Pack 172 website. Link: <http://www.cubscoutpack172.com/Home.aspx>
 - B. The PWD Chairs (Shawn & Christine Rivers) have the final decision authority on all race matters, including mishaps, rule interpretations, and other disputes.
 - C. The Pack is NOT providing race car "maintenance" supplies. If you want to guarantee that tools, glue guns, weights, and graphite will be available, you must bring them yourself or coordinate a Den Supply Box to have items available.
 - D. As stated previously, **the 9:30 AM check-in deadline is final**. It is every adult's responsibility to ensure their scout is present when their respective race begins. There are no "official" breaks in this PWD. When one event ends, the next will begin almost immediately.
- Bottom Line: **The scout must be present to race their car**. An adult or another scout CANNOT race someone else's car in their stead.
- E. Finish Line judges are NOT allowed to judge a given race if their scout is racing.
 - F. As a gesture of goodwill, the UC Firefighters may opt to participate. If so, they will compete with the adults. The firefighters will NOT be expected to abide by the rules as posted on the Pack 172 website, and they are not expected to be present during the official check-in.
 - G. Adults: The PWD is for the scouts. Don't take it too seriously. We're highlighting SPORTSMANSHIP. The "fun" is in the journey, not the destination. Awards may not be provided for Adult / Sibling races. You will, however, win bragging rights for the year that you have the fastest car.
 - H. There is a playground available for use on site and "Other" activities will be available to fill the scouts' free time when they are not racing.
